Rotarian Gene Trammell introduced Mary Moyer, the 6th-12th Curriculum Director for Baldwin County Board of Education. She shared perceptions of what curriculum is and spoke on the move from the 20-year-old Quality Core Curriculum (QCC) to Georgia Performance Standard (GPS). The definition she gave for curriculum is "what topics must be mastered for a particular course."

is the "what" of what is taught. The QCC was reviewed in 2002 and found lacking and not aligned with any national standards. The revisions are currently under review and in June GPS will go to the Georgia Department of Education for approval. The five-year implementation plan begins in fall 2004 in selected grades and subjects.

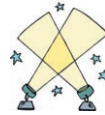
