After the players from Guys & Dolls sang two numbers from the upcoming musical (August 7th-10th), Judge Hulane George spoke to Rotary about fighting the root of the war on drugs. In the past, the courts have been giving drug offenders longer and harsher sentences. Judge George's plan is a Drug Treatment Court that is very "hands-on" and will go into effect on August 15. The root of the problem is addiction and she wants to combat addiction



as the system educates and helps offenders get off drugs, and stay off drugs. The Drug Treatment Court is a pilot program which will start in Milledgeville-Baldwin County. If the defendant is a first time offender and has no violent charges on his record, he/she can choose DTC. During the first phase, he/she has to appear before the court on the first and third Friday of each month for three months, while attending AA/NA. She hopes to be able to reach thirty-five defendants in the first year.
