Last Week - November 20th

Program: **Nicole Mitchell**
 Rotarian Ed Hall introduced Nicole Mitchell, Assistant Archives, from Georgia College & State University who presented a program on the history of the Georgia State Penitentiary. **Nichole** explained the Penitentiary's construction actually began in 1811 with the completion in 1817. The location of the Penitentiary today would be the old courthouse area. The main cell block would be where the main campus fountain was constructed. In Nicole's search, she found many detail records on the prisoners. During 1825, the uniforms of the prisoners consisted of cheap, blue material with white stripes. The prisoner's work week consisted of 8 - 10 hour days, 6 days a week. No lights were allowed in the prison cells, prisoners were not allowed to read or have conversation. Some of the crimes committed by the prisoners were: horse stealing, murder, mail theft, etc. Extreme punishment consisted of being whipped 10-40 strikes with a paddle, or Sunday isolation with just bread and water.

An honorary member is elected for one year only, and continuing membership must be renewed annually. Honorary members cannot propose new members to the club, do not hold office and are exempt from attendance requirements and club dues. Truly, those selected for honorary membership are those who have done much to further the ideals of Rotary.
