Program: **The Masonic Home of Georgia**

David Daniel introduced John Snipes, Home Superintendent of The Masonic Home of Georgia. The home is located on 650 acres in Macon and is funded by the Georgia Masons. The Masonic Home initially provided care for the elderly as well as children. In 1912, the leaders made the decision to admit children only from that time on. Since then, Snipes reported the Home has served 2,500 children. The Home's cost per child ranges from \$30 - \$40,000 to support their needs. Snipes said their main goal is to place children back home, if possible but stated this does not usually happen. At the current time, they have 33 children living in the Home with ages from 7 years to 24 years. These children have the opportunity to go to college. The Home's staff live on campus and are on call 24 hours a day. Snipes said the work is tough, but rewarding. The Masonic Home has always sought to provide the physical, educational and spiritual needs of the children. A Higher Educational Fund enables children to attend colleges, universities, and trade schools.
