TODAY'S MEETING

Steven Johnson, interim CEO- ORMC Update

Steven Johnson has over 30 years' experience as a chief executive officer at several hospital systems.

Most recently, he was President and CEO at Bay Medical Center/Sacred Heart Health System in Panama City, Florida, a 313-bed public, not-for-profit safety



net hospital. The medical center, which received no tax support, was inside a joint venture which included a national, private, not-for-profit health care system and a national for-profit health care system. It is believed to be the only affiliation of its kind in the country.

At Bay Medical Center/Sacred Heart Health, Johnson replaced over 500,000 square feet of the campus which was six decades old. In his 12 years there, he also achieved five successful Joint Commission reviews, a designation as a Top 50 hospital by HealthGrades for five consecutive years and developed and implemented joint ventures in order to utilize inpatient beds.

Prior to that, Johnson was CEO at Coosa Valley Baptist Medical Center in Alabama. Johnson had full responsibility for a 226-bed hospital and a Diploma School of Nursing located on the same campus. Under Johnson's management, the hospital reported positive operating margins within one year.

Positive operating margins were achieved every fiscal year during Johnson's 15-year tenure.

In his previous job, Johnson spent four years as CEO of Citizens Baptist Medical Center in Alabama. There, he successfully merged two community boards, orchestrated the design, construction and operation of a premier 50,000 square foot ambulatory care center and successfully recruited physicians at both campuses in a variety of specialties.

Earlier in his career, Johnson was a CEO for a 71-bed facility in Alabama and a COO for a medical center in the same state for six years. He received his BS and a MS in Hospital and Health Administration from the University of Alabama. Johnson's extensive Board service includes the American College of Healthcare Executives; Voluntary Hospitals of America, Southeast; Florida Hospital Association, Alabama Hospital Association, and the American Heart Association, among others.
