Tom Glover is CEO of Cogentes, a Milledgeville based technology and business consulting firm that provides technology, marketing and business consulting and outsourcing services to small businesses, local governments, schools and non-profits worldwide. Cogentes has the distinction of being designated as Georgia's first and only Gold Level Bicycle Friendly Business by the League of American Cyclists.



Tom is a native of Washington County. He attended Georgia Institute of Technology and graduated with a Computer Science degree from Southern Tech. In 2006 Tom and his wife, Amy, moved their family from Atlanta to Milledgeville in order to be closer to family and raise their children in a more family-oriented environment. In 2007 Tom started Cogentes to provide IT support and services to small business.

In addition to his work with Cogentes, Tom is involved in a number of community endeavors, serving on the board of directors for the Milledgeville-Baldwin County Chamber of Commerce where he is the current board chair, the Oconee River Greenway Foundation, the GCSU IT Advisory Board and the Bicycling Club of Milledgeville, where he is serving as President. Tom has also served on the steering

committee for the Community Strategic Planning initiative, the Partners for Progress Business Development and Transportation committees and is an active partner with Live Healthy Baldwin, Georgia Cancer Support and the Georgia Interscholastic Cycling Association. Tom was a member of the 2014 Leadership Baldwin class and a 2015 graduate of the Georgia Academy for Economic Development.
