# What is the family treatment court?

Family treatment courts, or FTCs, were created as part of the drug court movement that began in 1989 for adult criminal cases. The first family treatment court started in 1995, and there are more than 300 in operation today.

These programs address substance-abuse and parenting within the child welfare system. Drug addiction typically leads to neglect, abuse and/or inadequate supervision of children and often results in their removal from the home. The FTCs utilize a multidisciplinary approach, recognizing that their clients who are parents, children and families often face a range of challenges in addition to a substance abuse disorder.

FTCs are characterized by active judicial leadership, a juvenile court judge, combined with significant partnership efforts from the Department of Family and Children Services and substance-abuse treatment professionals. These agencies are joined by other agencies and community-based service providers, mental health professionals, parent educators, probation specialists, child advocates, surveillance officers, and peer specialists.

Although participation in FTC by parents is technically voluntary, this program has the distinct advantage of providing more successful outcomes than any other substance abuse treatment approach, and parents are made aware that they are more likely to have their children returned to them. DFCS in our circuit is now routinely requiring FTC assessments for cases involving drug abuse.

#### The Baldwin County FTC

The Baldwin County FTC (Baldwin County is the fiscal agent), began on July 11, 2013, with a grant from the governor's office. It is currently receiving referrals from Baldwin, Jasper, Jones, Putnam and Wilkinson Counties. As of July 1, 2015, funds have become available for transportation for participants. This FTC uses evidenced-based treatment to improve outcomes.
