- Vocational Service calls on every Rotarian to work with integrity and contribute their expertise to the problems and needs of society.
- Community Service encourages every Rotarian to find ways to improve the quality of life for people in their communities and to serve the public interest.
- International Service exemplifies our global reach in promoting peace and understanding. We support this service avenue by sponsoring or volunteering on international projects, seeking partners abroad, and more.
- Youth Service recognizes the importance of empowering youth and young professionals through leadership development programs.

Preference will be given to programs that meet the following:

- Programs that are located in Baldwin County;
- Programs that meet a critical community need;
- Programs that identify a specific need as opposed to providing for operating funds, see avenue of service; and
- Programs with low administrative and operating cost ratios.

Milledgeville Rotary will partner with one organization for one year (beginning August 1) providing volunteer support once a quarter in addition to financial support that will be awarded twice per year. Milledgeville Rotary will also relay information for additional volunteer needs to our membership for support throughout the year.
